=<u>MAJOR CHARACTERS OF THE BIBLE</u>= Lesson 1 Noah

SCRIPTURE: Read Genesis 6:5 – 9:19.

I. <u>NOAH AS A MAN</u>.

- 1. <u>The word "Noah" means "rest</u>." This makes him a type of salvation.
- 2. <u>He was the tenth from Adam</u>. Ten is the number of testing.
- 3. <u>He was the grandson of Methuselah</u>. (Tell something interesting about Methuselah.)
- 4. Nothing is mentioned about Noah in the Bible until he was 500 years old.
- 5. <u>He had three sons</u>: Shem (the father of the Jews), Ham (the father of the colored race), and Japheth (the father of the white race).
- 6. <u>He walked with God</u>. Notice Genesis 6:9.
- 7. <u>He was saved by grace</u>. See Genesis 6:8.
- 8. <u>He was a mature Christian</u>. In Genesis 6:9, notice the words, "Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations." The word "perfect" means "mature" or "complete."
- 9. <u>He was a preacher of righteousness</u>. See II Peter 2:5.
- 10. He was six hundred years old when the flood started. Read Genesis 7:6.
- II. <u>NOAH AS A TYPE</u>. Two people before the flood "walked with God." One was Enoch, and one was Noah. See Genesis 5:22-24. Both were saved from the flood. Enoch was caught up before the flood, picturing the Gentile bride being called out before the Tribulation. Noah was preserved through the flood, a type of the Jewish nation which will be preserved through the Tribulation.

III. <u>THE ARK</u>.

- 1. The ark was 300 cubits long, 50 cubits wide, and 30 cubits high. Read Genesis 6:15.
- 2. <u>It was made of gopher wood</u>. See Genesis 6:14a.
- 3. <u>It was sealed with pitch</u>. Notice Genesis 6:14c. Pitch is the blood of a tree. Our salvation is also sealed with the blood from a tree.
- 4. <u>It had one window, and this window was above</u>. Review Genesis 6:16a. God never let Noah see the flood or the tragedies on earth. He kept his eyes on things above. Here is a lesson on optimism.
- 5. <u>There was a door in the side of the ark</u>. See Genesis 6:16b. This pictures Jesus, our door to Heaven. See John 10:9. The door in the side pictures the wounded side of Christ.
- 6. <u>There were three stories</u>. Read Genesis 6:16c. This pictures the Trinity.
- 7. <u>Noah had to choose to go in the ark</u>. Notice Genesis 7:7.
- 8. <u>God shut him in</u>. Review Genesis 7:16. This is security.
- 9. <u>The ark was lifted up above the earth</u>. See Genesis 7:17. This is a picture of Jesus being lifted up from the earth.
- 10. There were eight saved in the ark. Read Genesis 7:13. Eight is the number of the new beginning.
- 11. <u>God gave the rainbow</u>. Study Genesis 9:13. This pictures the fact that God will never judge our sins again. The seven colors in the rainbow picture the completion of salvation.
